Tier level Description

Testing refers to any set of tests done on a case. Since every case is different, the testing performed will be different and based on the clinical signs, history, and autopsy findings.

- Tier 1: Allows up to \$120 of testing above the base necropsy fee. Example: This would include gross exam and histopathology if indicated, plus ~2-3 other tests.
- Tier 2: Allows \$120.01 \$300.00 of testing above the base necropsy fee. Most scours and respiratory cases fall in this category. The client will incur additional fees for testing that exceeds \$300.

Note: If you select Tier 2 but the pathologist can get a diagnosis for less, we will charge you for Tier 1 (we will always lower the price if we can).
