Tier Level Descriptions

Testing refers to any set of tests done on a case. Since every case is different, the testing performed will be different and based on the clinical signs, history and autopsy findings.

Tier 1 - Allows up to \$90 of testing.

Example: This would include microscope examination of the tissues plus 2-3 other tests

Tier 2 - Allows \$90.01 – 225.00 of testing.

Most scours and respiratory cases fall in this category.

The client will incur additional fees for testing that exceeds \$225

Note: If you select Tier 2 but the pathologist can get a diagnosis for less, we will charge you for a Tier 1 (we will always lower the price if we can).

Questions to Consider when Completing the History Section

- 1. What signs did the animal have and for how long?
- 2. If you have other animals, are they experiencing the same signs?
- 3. Did the animal have neurological signs such as foaming at the mouth, paralysis, tremors or shaking, trouble walking, ear droop?
- 4. What medications or treatments was the animal given?
- 5. Has the animal been vaccinated? If so, when and what for?
- 6. Was the animal eating/drinking?
- 7. Has there been any change in food or water?
- 8. Have any new animals been introduced to your farm recently?
- 9. Do you go to shows or sale barns? If yes, when was the last one?
